

IMPORTANT: Holders of foreign PhD degrees (not obtained in Portugal) should read this for job applications (Grants and scholarships do not require this condition)

PhD degree must be recognized by a Portuguese institution or the DGES (Higher education Directorate). The process of recognition/diploma registration depends on which country the applicant obtained the PhD degree, namely:

- **Applicants that obtained their PhD in** Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Czech Republic, Cyprus, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Moldavia, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Romania, Russia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine, United Kingdom and United States should register their PhD degree according to the instructions available

in <http://www.dges.gov.pt/en/pagina/diploma-registration> (process regulated by Decree Law No. 341/2007, of 12 October; Decree Law No. 283/83, of 21 June; Portaria N.º. 227/2017, 25 July).
